Upgrading to Version 7.0.0

Upgrading Stand-Alone Installations

- Capture Pro Version 7.0 is a 64-bit application. Therefore, your PC operating system must be 64-bit in order to upgrade.
- The customer's Capture Pro Software Serial Number must be entitled to the 7.0 release
 - The Entitlement Date (or Software Assurance Expiration Date) must be July 1, 2025 or later
- To upgrade, download the installer (CapProSW_7_0_0.exe) file from <u>www.kodakalaris.com/go/captureprodownload</u> and run it.
 - The installer will automatically upgrade an existing Capture Pro install to Version 7.0.0
 - When upgrading from Version 6.2 or earlier, an Internet connection is required during the upgrade as the KODAK Alaris licensing system will generate a new 7.0 license
 - If an Internet connection is not available or allowed, the installation wizard will guide you through the off-line process of obtaining (and installing) a license from a PC that does ha Internet access

Upgrading to Version 7.0.0 (continued)

Upgrading Network Edition Installations

- Capture Pro Version 7.0 is a 64-bit application. Therefore, the PC operating system on the NE Client workstations must be 64-bit in order to upgrade.
- Both the NE Server and the NE Client workstations must be upgraded to Version 7.0 at the same time.
 - You cannot run a Version 6.2 client workstation with a Version 7.0 NE Server
 - You cannot run a Version 7.0 client workstation with a Version 6.2 NE Server
- To upgrade, download the installer files from <u>www.kodakalaris.com/go/captureprodownload</u> and run them
 - IIS on the Network Edition Server must be STOPPED prior to the upgrade and RESTARTED after the upgrade

Upgrading to Version 7.0.0 (continued)

- Q: Can a Subscription customer upgrade to Version 7.0?
- A: Yes. Subscription customers are entitled to new releases that come out during their Subscription timeframe.
 - Prior to upgrading to Version 7.0, the Subscription customer should
 - Download and install the new License Manager program from the Capture Pro Software website: <u>www.kodakalaris/com/go/captureprodownload</u>.
 - Contact Service and Support with their Hardware ID and their intention to upgrade.
 - A new Version 7.0 Subscription license, with the same Group level and Expiration Date, will be created for the customer's Hardware ID.
 - Service and Support will then contact the customer indicating that their Version 7.0 subscription license is ready, and that the customer can now upgrade to Version 7.0.

S5000 Scanner Support

- Limited Edition will NOT be available for the S5000 Scanners
- Button Support
 - Up to 20 buttons can be configured for use from the Scanner OCP or the system tray icon for Capture Pro
- Intelligent Job Select and Sorting
 - Fully supported at scanner rated speed just like the i5x50 Scanners
 - Intelligent Job Select patch sheets can be sorted out to the Rear Exit tray
- Imprinting and Image Addressing
 - Imprinting is fully supported when scanner has an imprinter installed. Configuration is done in Job Setup.
 - Image Addressing with the S5210 is fully supported, just like the i5850. Configuration is done in Job Setup.



S5000 Scanner Support (continued)

- Tri-stream Support
 - Version 7 fully supports the ability of the S5000 Scanners (as well as the i5x50 Scanners) to scan in tri-stream
 - Tri-stream is Dropped-Out Bitonal, Full Bitonal, and Full Color/Grayscale
 - All 3 images will be assigned to the same Page ID in Capture Pro and the dropped-out image will be received first
 - This allows zonal OCR indexing to be done using the dropped-out image
 - Note that <u>tri-stream output is NOT supported</u>
 - Both bitonal images will be included in the output unless customer deletes the dropped-out image prior to output
 - The Remove Blank Images function is a great way to quickly identify and delete the dropped-out images

Application Architecture

- Only 64-bit operating systems are supported
 - Windows 10, 11, Server 2016, Server 2019, Server 2022
- Recommended PC Configuration
 - i5 Gen 12 processor or greater
 - 16 GB RAM
 - 10 GB of free space (more if scanning higher volumes)
 - SSD Drives
- Database Lookup and Output via ODBC
 - For Database Lookup, only 64-bit ODBC Data Sources are supported
 - For output to an ODBC database, a 32-bit ODBC Source is still required
- Plug-In Support
 - Custom System Output Destinations (SOD) that have been implemented, will continue to be supported
 - Only 32-bit SODs are currently supported
 - Other custom plug-ins are currently NOT supported
 - Index Type
 - Index Data
 - Batch Naming
 - Data Provider

Quick Start View Updates

• New right-click menu provides easy access to edit, add, or rename a Job Setup





- The Color of each Job tile can also be configured
- Job Tiles will continue to be displayed in alphabetical order
- The icon on the Job tile reflects the output file type configured for the Job

PDF and sPDF Output Improvements

- Performance of PDF and Searchable PDF output is faster
 - Single-Page and Multi-Page file output
- Quality of PDF-MRC output has improved
 - New configurable options when PDF-MRC is enabled

Limited Edition Updates

- Up to 20 Batch and Document Index fields can now be configured
- 2-D bar code support
 - All 1-D and 2-D bar code types are now supported including
 - QR Code
 - DataMatrix
 - PDF-417
- Zonal OCR Indexing is now supported
 - Note that OMR indexing remains <u>unsupported</u> and requires the full version of Capture Pro Software

Problems Fixed in 7.0

- Hardware ID Changing due to Windows or BIOS Updates
 - Hardware ID algorithm has changed which will prevent the Hardware ID from changing when a Windows Update and/or BIOS update has taken place on your PC
 - There is a new License Manager for Version 7.0
 - If you have the License Manager program installed on your PC and you have upgraded to Version 7.0, then you should also upgrade your License Manager installation.
