KODAK ALARIS – REACH STATEMENT (4th July 2016)

REACH, Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006, was adopted in December, 2006. REACH stands for Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals. REACH entered into force on June 1, 2007, with implementation occurring in phases over an eleven-year period. It was designed to identify systematically the hazards and risks of chemicals allowing for appropriate risk management measures by industry and, if necessary, provide for further regulatory action by the public authorities.

Eastman Kodak followed the development and implementation of REACH for many years and since its formation in 2013, Kodak Alaris has continued following these requirements. Kodak Alaris is committed to meeting its legal obligations under REACH, whether as a manufacturer, importer or downstream user. Since the inception of REACH, first as Eastman Kodak and now Kodak Alaris, we have worked closely with our suppliers and customers to ensure continued compliance up and down the supply chain.

Kodak communicates to suppliers that they are required to provide material declarations and to update those declarations as new/revised regulatory requirements are defined. Based on information provided by our suppliers, I can confirm:-

All Kodak Alaris Safety Data Sheets (SDSs) meet the requirements of EC 1907/2006 and are available from our SDS webpage:-

Kodak Alaris meets all its requirements of REACH Article 33 on the Communication of information on substances in articles. Information about the presence of substances identified by the European Chemical Agency as candidates for Annex XIV of REACH (the so-called Candidate List), in Kodak Alaris articles at a concentration above 0.1% weight by weight is provided in accordance with Article 59(1) of the Regulation (EC) No. 1907/2006 can be obtained via our Product Declarations webpage:-
