

Helpful Tips to Keep Equipment Clean

The Kodak Alaris Environmental Health & Safety (EH&S) and the Services Team have provided a few recommendations that can be used as general guidance to ensure proper sanitation methods while servicing equipment.

1 Clean and disinfect surfaces of the equipment before beginning work

- Disconnect power to the equipment prior to cleaning surfaces.
- Wear gloves and observe cautions and instructions on labels or Safety Data Sheets for cleaning materials used.
- Touch screens may be damaged by abrasive or chemically aggressive cleaners and disinfectants. Manufacturers have recommended cleaning/disinfecting with a soft lintfree cloth dampened with a water/alcohol solution containing 50%-75% isopropyl alcohol (IPA). Do not spray solution directly on the screen. The screen should be wiped gently from top to bottom leaving a trace of solution on the screen. Avoid drips and forcing solution into screen edges (where it could loosen adhesive). Wait for the screen to dry before restoring power.
- Other equipment surfaces may be cleaned with non-abrasive over-the-counter cleaners (soap/detergent). Frequently touched surfaces (e.g. handles, keyboards, mouse, etc.) should also be disinfected by wiping down with the alcohol solution or any other EPA registered household disinfectant (spray solution on a clean cloth or use commercial wipe).

2 Clean and disinfect tools, computer, phone, etc. used on site (following recommendations above)

3 Dispose of gloves and wash hands when job is complete (use hand sanitizer if soap/water are not readily available)
